for an operational approach

▶ A Bouygues Construction **Environmental standards guide**; adapted to each of our businesses, detailing the responsibilities of the company as regards environment and the actions to be implemented around the following 11 themes:

Waste



Hazardous products



Noise nuisances



Air



Aquatic environment



Biodiversity



Energy consumption



Cleanliness and storage



Communication



Emergency situations

Indispensable actions are highlighted and must absolutely be respected on all our sites. Proposals of **Best practices** observed within the Group as well as presentations of **Eco-equipment** that respect the environment are also included in the guide.

Actions presented in the guide are in line with requirements relating to sites as laid down by the principal environmental certification bodies (BREEAM, LEED, HQE...).

▶ **An evaluation grid** is used to check the implementation of actions recommended in the environmental standards guide based on the 11 themes. More than 60 evaluation criteria were identified, graded according to three levels of performance.

▶ **An environmental label, *Ecosite***, is awarded based on results obtained from the above evaluation.

Ecosite is the environmental label of Bouygues Construction. It is our guarantee to our clients that we shall respect the environment and the neighbourhood in the execution of their sites.

The audit to obtain the label is conducted using the evaluation grid of the standards; generally the progress of site is between 15 and 25%.

The audit is performed by a team that is independent from the site (Quality Safety Environmental department). Follow-up audits are carried out to ensure that the criteria are adhered to throughout the duration of works.

The awarding of the Ecosite label is signified by the handing over of a flag that symbolises the commitment and the motivation of the teams. The flag is hoisted on site in the presence of the client, the company management, all the production team and the partners.
